All bid prices submitted shall be effective from date of bid award through May 1st, 2011.

It is understood and agreed that any Town, Village, School District or Fire District within Allegany County may also participate in this contract pursuant to Section 103, General Municipal Law. If the contract bidder sells a certain quantity of the bid items at a price below the Allegany County contract price to a political subdivision of Allegany County, the price to Allegany County must be reduced to the lower amount.

All bidders agree to defend and save Allegany County from and against all demands, claims, suits, costs, expenses, damages and adjustments based on any infringement of any patent relating to goods and materials specified in this bid.

A non-collusive bidding certificate must accompany all bids. All bids must be submitted on County provided bid sheets. Failure to provide a non-collusive bidding certificate or to submit a bid on the County provided form shall be cause for the bid to be rejected.

## INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS AND CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS APPLICABLE TO ALL BIDS AND AWARDS

By submitting a bid the bidder certifies and agree as follows:

1. that it will maintain normal business hours during the time in which the material bid will be needed by the County. Bidders agree that normal business hours shall mean 8:00 AM to 4:00PM. Bidders also acknowledge and agree that on some occasions it may be necessary to remain open before or beyond normal business hours in order to provide the County with the material bid.
2. that all materials proposed or materials supplied by the bidder to the County shall conform to the requirements set forth in Standard Specifications, Construction and Materials manual published by the New York State Department of Transportation, Office of Engineering, January 2, 1990 (English measurement not metric) or to any other standard or standards for such materials or sources of materials specifically set forth in these specifications. If the materials bid or the source of the materials bid are subject to certification or approval by the New York State Department of Transportation for materials or sources of materials which are purchased by the State of New York, the bidder certifies that the materials bid or proposed and/or the source of such materials are currently approved and/or certified by the New York State Department of Transportation for use by the State of New York and the bidder shall furnish with his bid proof of such current approval or certification.
3. that the Superintendent of Public Works may order tests of the materials proposed by a bidder or supplied by a successful bidder, at any time, and that the costs of such testing shall be the responsibility of the bidder and/or successful bidder as the case may be. BID SPECIFICATIONS FOR 1311 CALCIUM CHLORIDE

Description:

1311 Calcium Chloride Brine is a natural material composed of Calcium Chloride salts in water solution. In this form, 1311 is effective when used for soil stabilization, dust suppression and ice control. The brine is applied, as required, by the supplier or is delivered to bulk storage for future use by the owner.

Material:

The brine supplied shall meet the following minimum concentration requirements expressed as percentage by weight:

Calcium Chloride 13.5%

Certification of these minimum standards will be furnished at the request of the customer. Any deviation from these specifications must be approved by the County Superintendent of Public Works.

Delivery Requirements:

Furnished as a delivered and applied item, the brine will be applied directly to the prepared surface. Application shall be accomplished through a tank vehicle equipped with a positive displacement pump and variable length spray bar. Adequate controls will be provided, as an integral part of the spraying unit, to accurately apply between 0.1 and 1.0 gallons per square yard.

Method of Measurement:

The quantity to be paid for will be the number of gallons delivered or gallons delivered and applied.
