



## New Procedures for Electronic Waste (E-Waste) Collection and Recycling

For the first time in 10 years, Allegany County will be charged by electronics recycling companies to accept our recycled E-Waste. As a result, Allegany County must modify its current E-waste Collection Program to save taxpayers money.

**Effective March 31, 2017, recyclable electronics (E-Waste) will no longer be accepted at County Transfer Stations on a daily basis.**

To meet the need for residential E-Waste recycling, Allegany County will provide **FREE** E-Waste collection events at the County Landfill, 6006 County Route 48, Angelica, NY 14709. To participate in the events, County residents will need to present upon arrival any one of the following:

1. Current Allegany County Solid Waste Residential Disposal Permit a.k.a “Hang Tag” (or)
2. Allegany County Solid Waste Disposal Ticket a.k.a “Mark Off Ticket” (or)
3. Allegany County Solid Waste Recycling Permit (Available free of charge to all County Residents)
