

ALLEGANY COUNTY—BELMONT, NY-- ASSISTANT PUBLIC DEFENDER

The Allegany County Public Defender's Office is seeking applications to fill a full-time attorney position commencing in January 2018. Initially, the attorney's primary responsibility will be to provide counsel at arraignment in the 35 Allegany County Justice Courts. The attorney must be available to work off-hours for at least 5 evenings and overnights/week including some weekends. Admission to the NYS Bar and possession of a valid NYS driver's license are required. It is anticipated that the duties will expand to a more traditional caseload-centered practice once the Allegany County CAFA program becomes more established.

Salary is \$70,000 plus benefits, including health insurance and membership in the NYS retirement system.
