NOW, THEREFORE, permission is hereby granted to said \_\_\_\_\_ to do said work upon the following conditions.

**CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS**

This permit shall not be assigned or transferred without the written consent of the County Superintendent of Public Works.

The work authorized by this permit shall be performed under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the County Superintendent of Public Works or his representative.

Particular attention is called to the necessity of thoroughly compacting the back fill, which will be required by the County Superintendent.

The County Superintendent of Public Works shall be given one week's notice by said applicant of the date when it intends to begin work authorized by this permit, and prompt notice of its completion.

The said applicant hereby agrees to hold the State, County and Town harmless on account of damages of any kind which may arise during the progress of the work authorized by this permit or by reason thereof.

Applicant certifies all persons concerned with actual work under this permit are duly covered by Workmen's Compensation Insurance and the State, County and Town shall be held harmless on account thereof.

The County Superintendent of Public Works reserves the right to at any time revoke or annul this permit should the applicant fail to comply with the terms and conditions upon which it is granted.

The applicant agrees to pay all necessary expenses incident to supervision and inspection by reason of the granting of such permit as certified by the County Superintendent of Public Works, such payment to be made within ten days from the rendered of the certified account.

Applicant agrees to provide adequate barriers and lights to protect the public. No County sign or traffic device shall be disturbed.

Work under this permit to be commenced within thirty days from date of permit and continued in an expeditious manner.

The applicant shall submit a detailed plan of structure to be built, with a description of proposed method of construction. Pavement to be returned to its original condition.

Traffic shall be maintained by the applicant on this section of the highway while the work is in progress and until its final completion.

It is understood that should future changes in the highway construction or use should make necessary changes in the proposed work covered by this application and permit, the applicant shall on reasonable notice from the County Superintendent make such necessary changes at its own expense within the time so specified in notice.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR PERMIT TO DIG ACROSS  
COUNTY PAVEMENT**

1. Backfill material will meet state specifications for Item #4 (Section 304.2 Of the Standard Spec. Manual)
2. The above material will be mixed with Portland cement as follows: 1 part Portland cement to 12-15 parts Item #4.
3. The backfill will be replaced in 6" lifts and compacted thoroughly each time with a vibratory compactor until cut is filled within 6" of the level of the existing pavement. This should be done in accordance with Section 203 of the Standard Specs Manual.
4. The **LAST 6"** of the cut will be 4" of Type 1 Base or Type 3 Base Asphalt concrete mix and 2" of Type 6F or 7F Top. Each layer will meet the state specification (Section 400) for that item and will be thoroughly compacted.
5. When a corporation or another municipality intends to disturb (excavate, bore, etc...) the pavement or the shoulder, at least 48 hours advance notification shall be made to the County at the above phone number, so that arrangements can be made for a representative from the Public Works Department to be present while the fill is being replaced.
6. The **ONLY** exception to condition #5 is: In the event of an emergency, excavation can be done after phone notification of your intentions.
7. Cold patch may be used to fill the last 6" of the cut, if the weather prohibits obtaining the asphalt concrete mix specified in condition #4.
