Convicted of a Felony?

You may still have the right to vote when convicted of a Felony-Your registration is automatically cancelled; however you may be able to immediately restore your right to vote if one of the following applies to you:

- You are only serving probation
- You were not sentenced to prison or your prison sentence was suspended
- You served your MAXIMUM sentence
- You were discharged from parole
- You were pardoned

If you still have the right to vote~ you should register again with your local Board of Elections

You DO NOT have the right to vote if:

- You are currently in jail (unless you have not yet been convicted of a felony on day of election)
- You are on parole
