TITLE: ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 1-72, PRINT NO. 1, PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF AN ANNUAL SUM TO CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES AFTER FIFTEEN YEARS OF CONTINUOUS FULL-TIME COUNTY EMPLOYMENT

RESOLVED:

1. That proposed Local Law, Intro. No. 1-72, Print No. 1, is hereby adopted without any change in language, to wit:

SECTION ONE: All county officers and employees, except those employees covered under any agreement as a result of negotiations under the Public Employees' Fair Employment Act of the State of New York, who have completed or shall complete fifteen or more years of continuous full-time county employment on or after the effective date of this local law and remain in a full-time continuous employment status, shall annually receive the sum of \$200.00 in such manner and at such time as the County Board of Legislators shall prescribe by resolution.

SECTION TWO: This local law which is subject to permissive referendum shall take effect on the date it is filed in the office of the secretary of state.
