TITLE: ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW, INTRO. NO. 2-72, PRINT NO. 1, ESTABLISHING A TRAFFIC SAFETY BOARD FOR THE COUNTY OF ALLEGANY

RESOLVED:

1. That proposed Local Law, Intro. No. 2-72, Print No. 1, is hereby adopted without any change in language, to wit:

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING A TRAFFIC SAFETY BOARD FOR THE COUNTY OF ALLEGANY

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established a traffic safety board for the County of Allegany.

SECTION 2. The said board shall consist of fifteen members appointed by the board of legislators.

SECTION 3. All of the provisions of article forty-three of the vehicle and traffic law of the State of New York shall apply to said traffic safety board.

SECTION 4. This local law shall take effect on the date it is filed in the office of the secretary of state.
