

RESOLUTION NO. 184-71

TITLE: ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 1-71, PRINT NO. 1, PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ANNUAL SALARIES FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS

Offered by: Legislator William B. Grossman

RESOLVED:

1. That proposed Local Law, Intro. No. 1-71, Print No. 1, is hereby adopted without any change in language, to wit:

SECTION 1. Commencing January 1, 1972 the annual salary of the County Judge shall be the sum of Twenty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$29,950.00).

SECTION 2. Commencing January 1, 1972 the annual salary of the Director of Planning shall be the sum of Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$13,800.00).

SECTION 3. Commencing January 1, 1972 the annual salary of the County Superintendent of Highways shall be the sum of Twelve Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$12,800.00).

SECTION 4. Commencing January 1, 1972 the annual salary of the County Attorney shall be the sum of Twelve Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$12,600.00).

SECTION 5. This Local Law, which is subject to permissive referendum, shall take effect on the date it is filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
