Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Human Services Committee Chair Judith Hopkins at 12:45 p.m.

Loyola Recovery Foundation Inc. Agreement

Community Services Director Dr. Robert Anderson requested a resolution to enter into agreement with Loyola Recovery Foundation, Inc. (Loyola), for Inpatient/Outpatient Substance Abuse Treatment services for the term commencing January 1, 2019, and expiring December 31, 2019. The County agrees to pay Loyola, \$25,000 initial consideration and authorizes the County to pass-through to Loyola any additional amounts allocated or awarded to Loyola by the New York State Office of Alcohol and Substance Abuse Services during the term of this Agreement. Legislator Decker asked how many beds will be included. Dr. Anderson indicated he included 20 beds; however, he cannot guarantee what they will need. Legislator Graves asked if unused beds can be rented. Dr. Anderson stated, yes, all facilities state-wide are open for use. Dr. Anderson indicated that back in February there was an 80 percent chance these funds would be received; however, it is now down to a 20 percent chance. Legislator Barnes asked why the change, and Dr. Anderson indicated it was due to state finances. Legislator Root asked how much we could potentially receive. Dr. Anderson stated anywhere up to \$300,000. Legislator Decker asked how they are handling maintenance, staffing, and operational costs. Dr. Anderson stated the County is just a pass-through. Loyola is responsible for all other liabilities. This request was approved on a motion made by Legislator Decker, seconded by Legislator Root, and carried. **Refer to Ways and Means**

There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting was adjourned at 12:55 p.m. following a motion made by Legislator Stockin, seconded by Legislator Root, and carried.
