



PROVISIONAL OPENING FOR
Public Health Sanitarian

There is a **provisional opening in the Allegany County Department of Health for a full time Public Health Sanitarian.

Salary range: \$25.8794/hr ~ \$33.2533/hr.

A sanitarian under supervision performs professional activities, which include the investigation and inspection of the non-engineering aspects of environmental health control. A sanitarian investigates nuisance conditions and complaints, interprets laboratory reports, provides training, assistance, and supervision to subordinate (Public Health Technician) and support (clerical) personnel, maintains documentation, prepares reports, makes recommendations, and testifies at enforcement proceedings. Does related work as required.

Good knowledge of environmental health practices; ability to supervise the work of others; ability to develop good public relations; ability to work well with civic groups, public officials and the general public; ability to prepare and deliver effective talks and presentations; ability to train others in environmental health work; good professional judgment; good presence; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- (a) must possess a baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited or New York State-registered college or university with 30 credit hours in the natural sciences, of which not more than twelve (12) credit hours may be in the applied sciences, and have satisfactorily completed a public health training course approved by the State Health Department within two years of appointment; or
- (b) may be a public health technician who possesses five years of experience as a public health technician deemed satisfactory by the local commissioner of health or public health director and have satisfactorily completed a public health training course approved by the State Health Department.

PROMOTIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

Currently employed as a public health technician with Allegany County with five years of permanent competitive class status as a public health technician. Such service must be deemed satisfactory by the public health director. Must have satisfactorily completed a public health training course approved by the State Health Department.

*The term natural science shall mean a science such as biology, chemistry or physics that deals with the objects, phenomena, or laws of natural and physical world. It shall include all physical and biological sciences.

Qualifications pursuant to NYS Sanitary Code §11.111

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Must satisfactorily complete a public health training course approved by the New York State Department of Health within two years of appointment; and possession of an appropriate New York State Motor Vehicle driver's license at the time of appointment.

**This is a competitive class position, provisional candidate *must pass the examination for this position and be ranked among the top three (3) candidates and receive an offer of employment for this position.*

**** Residency -Candidates must be residents of Allegany County or a contiguous county for at least one month prior to the date of exam.**

Interested candidates may submit a complete Civil Service application to the Human Resource/Civil Service Department along with a copy of their college transcripts. There is no fee at this time.
