**Resolution Opposing Driver's License for Undocumented Individuals**

A draft resolution was presented opposing the passage of Senate Bill S01747 and  
Assembly Bill A03675 known as the "Driver's License Access and Privacy Act," that would amend  
the vehicle and traffic law in relation to authorizing the Department of Motor Vehicles to issue  
standard drivers' licenses. This request was approved on a motion made by Legislator Graves,

**Public Safety Committee**

**Jail Physician-Medical Director Position**

Sheriff Whitney requested permission to create one part-time Jail Physician-Medical  
Director (Section IV Salary Plan). This position is needed as it was abolished when the current  
County Medical Director only contracted with the Health Department and is needed to meet State  
Commission of Corrections regulations. The annual salary of this position is \$20,000 and is not  
eligible for benefits. This position is funded 100 percent with County funds. This request was  
approved on a motion made by Legislator Stockin, seconded by Legislator Ricci, and carried.  
**Prepare Resolution to create the position and refer to Ways and Means to fill**

### **Board of Elections**

Elections Commissioners Brent Reynolds and Mike McCormick attended the meeting to briefly discuss upcoming events. Mr. McCormick provided the following dates of events:

- May 14 there will be a special election in Clarksville that the Board of Elections will be assisting with.
- May 15 through May 18 they will be training inspectors at the Crossroads Conference Center where they plan to see 165 trainees and will hold eight different sessions.
- May 21 they will be hosting school elections at Wellsville Central School.
- June 25 will be the County-wide primary election. Polls will be open from 12:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
