

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON MODIFICATION AND CONTINUATION OF
AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT NUMBER THREE WITHIN THE TOWNS OF
ALMOND, BIRDSALL, BURNS, AND GROVE AND THE
VILLAGES OF ALMOND AND CANASERAGA**

NOTICE is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Allegany County Board of Legislators at the Legislative Chambers, Room 221, County Office Building, Belmont, New York, on May 28, 2019, at 2:00 p.m., on the modification and continuation of Agricultural District Number Three which was created within the Towns of Almond, Birdsall, Burns, and Grove and the Villages of Almond and Canaseraga by Resolution No. 158-2002 on May 28, 2002.

The County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board has made a report and recommended that the District be continued with modifications. These modifications entail the inclusion of approximately 1,148.43 acres of predominantly viable agricultural land and the removal of approximately 44.69 acres of predominantly viable agricultural land. The continuation and requested modifications to Agricultural District Number Three will result in 160 landowners enrolling approximately 16,668.74 acres.

A description and map of the District, the reports and recommendations of the County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board may be examined at the Office of the Soil and Water Conservation District Board, Agricultural Service Center, 5425 County Road 48, Belmont, New York, 14813, and the Allegany County Clerk's Office, 7 Court Street, Belmont, New York, 14813, during regular business hours.

All parties in interest and citizens will be heard by the County Board of Legislators at said public hearing.
